CIRCULAR

Sub: Dress Code for Students on Campus

All students are hereby informed that they are required to strictly adhere to the prescribed dress code when present in the academic areas of the campus. The academic areas include Classrooms, Lecture Halls, Corridors of the Academic Blocks, Seminar Halls, Laboratories, Research labs/centers, Auditoriums, Conference Rooms, Computer Labs, Libraries, Faculty Cabins, Administrative Offices, etc.

Students must wear uniforms (where applicable), formal pants and shirts, churidars, long kurtis, and formal footwear or shoes. Dresses that conceal the identity of students, low-waist, torn, cut, or tight jeans, sleeveless garments or transparent tops, miniskirts, tube tops or spaghetti tops, T-shirts with derogatory or inappropriate writings, shorts, dhotis, capris, etc., are not allowed on campus.

All students are advised to ensure that their attire is appropriate and aligns with the guidelines outlined above. The school heads and the chief wardens are entrusted with monitoring compliance, and cases of non-compliance may be forwarded to the Office of Student Affairs as and when reported. This policy aims to maintain the decorum and professionalism of the university environment and will be implemented with immediate effect.
