**Notification – Supplementary Examination Registration (Odd Semester AY 2025 - 2026)**

Registration for Supplementary Examination - Odd Semester AY 2025 - 2026 is as per the following schedule:

**Start Date : 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2025, 10 AM**

**End Date : 20<sup>th</sup> September 2025, 5 PM**

**Process and Terms for Registration**

- Registration for supplementary exam is only through the MyAmrita Portal.
- Access the portal using the link [My Amrita](#) and login using your University email ID.
- For registering,  
Click Supplementary Registrations -- > Registration Forms.  
Select the course, choose mode (Supplementary Regular – General; Supplementary Direct 100 – 100 Supply) and proceed to pay the fees.

- **For School of computing (CSE, AIE & CYS):**
  - a. **Supplementary Regular (General)** Students who have not exhausted the 4 attempts (Regular +3 consecutive Supplementary attempts).
  - b. **Supplementary Direct 100 (100 Supply)** - Students who have exhausted 4 attempts (Regular + 3 consecutive Supplementary attempts).
- **For schools other than computing:**

A student who has secured an “F” grade in a course can register for the **Supplementary Regular Examination (General)** with the internal marks secured during the regular semester. Alternatively, the student can register for the **Supplementary Direct 100 Examination (100 Supply)**, where the internal marks will not be considered, irrespective of the number of supplementary attempt count.
- Please note that once a course is registered as Supplementary Direct 100, it cannot be reverted to Supplementary Regular with internals. The only alternative is to register for the course during the next offering through Re-Registration or Runtime Redo

- Once the registration is completed in any one of the above categories, change of registration mode from General to 100 Supply or Vice versa will not be permitted.
- Courses with “FA” grade, registration cancelled due to Malpractice, courses that were dropped and Lab courses cannot be registered. Please check your semester grade sheet before you apply.
- Term out students (students who have completed the duration of study but have not cleared the subjects) applications will not be processed without Course Extension Forms.

UG - Regular (All Programs) : Rs.700/- per subject.

UG - Term out (All Programs) : Rs.1500/- per subject.

PG- All Categories (All Programs) : Rs.1000/- per subject.
