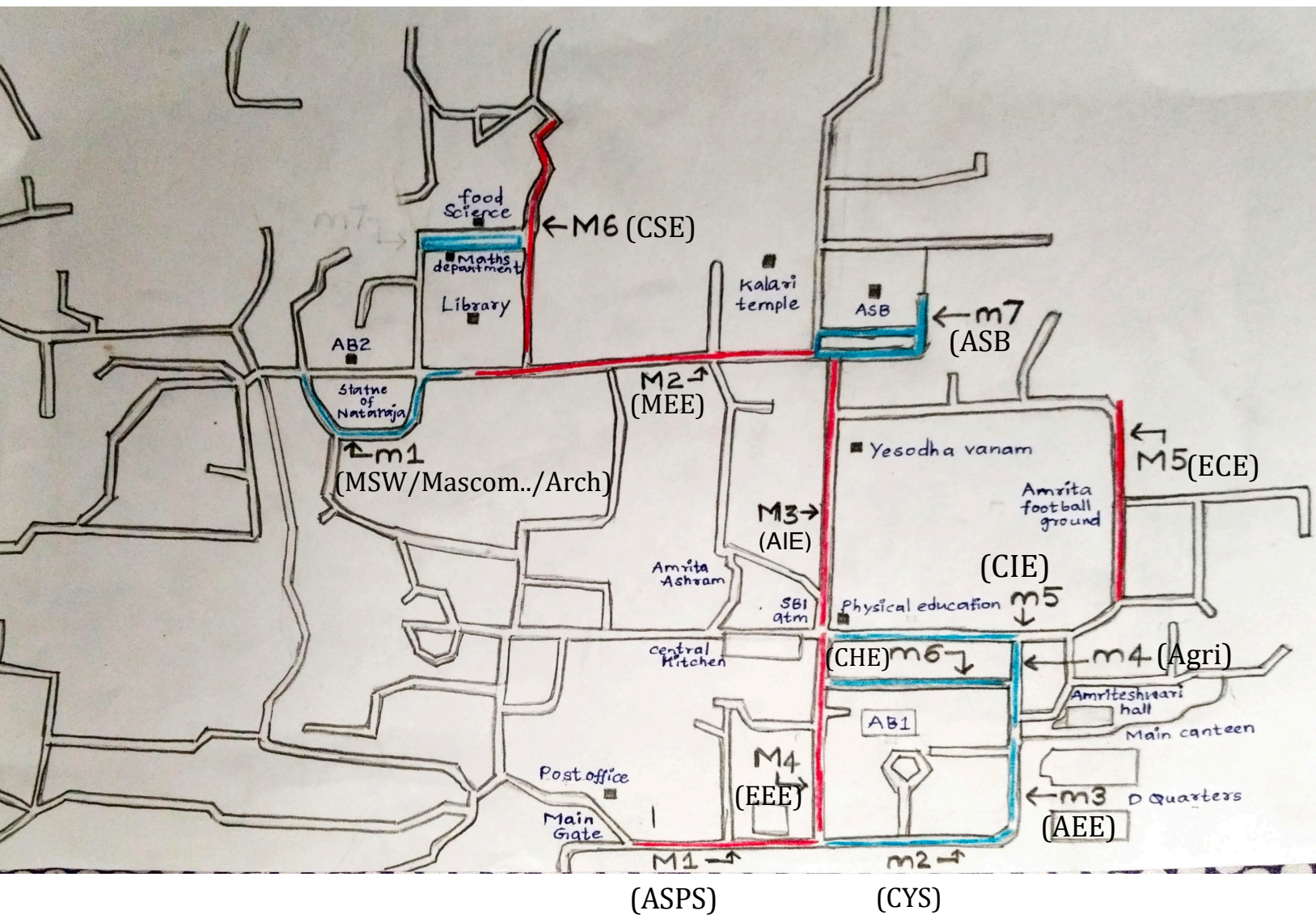


Gokulashtami 2025 Campus Decoration



Gokulashtami 2025 Roads Description Map



Major Roads – Description

Major 1 (ASPS): Main Gate to AB1 – 3rd Line

Connects the main gate of the campus to the third internal road near AB1 academic block.

Major 2 (MEE): Library 2nd Entrance to ASB Turn

Runs from the second entrance of the library to the starting point of the road turning towards the ASB block.

Major 3 (AIE) : ASB to SBI ATM

Starts at the ASB block and ends at the SBI ATM, covering central campus zones.

Major 4 (EEE): SBI ATM to Dead End

Extends straight from the SBI ATM and ends at a terminal point.

Major 5 (ECE): Ground Slope to AB4 Road

Connects the sloped ground area to the road leading to AB4 building.

Major 6 (CSE) : Central Area(Arjun Statue) to Green Gate (Swimming Pool)

Connects the central part of the campus to the Green Gate near the swimming pool.

Minor Roads – Description

Minor 1 (MSW/Mascom./Arch) : Nataraj Statue Circle (Road) to Library Entrance
Connects the Nataraj Statue Circle (full circle) to the second entrance of the library.

Minor 2 (CYS) : AB1 – 3rd Line to 1st Line
Internal road linking the third and first lines (Saraswati Statue Road), in front of the AB1 building, to D Quarters.

Minor 3 (AEE) : D Quarters to Amriteshwari Hall (via Main Canteen)
Connects D Quarters to Amriteshwari Hall (Amrita map board) — including the Amriteshwari Hall circle — passing through the main canteen area.

Minor 4 (Agri) : Amriteshwari Hall to EEE Lab Dead End
Leads from Amriteshwari Hall (Amrita map board) to the dead end near the EEE Lab.

Minor 5 (CIE) : Mech Shed to EEE Lab (SBI ATM)
Runs from the Mechanical Lab Sheds to the EEE Lab near the SBI ATM.

Minor 6 (CHE) : Powerhouse 1 to Labs (near Parking)
Links Powerhouse 1 to nearby laboratories located near the parking area (dead end).

Minor 7 (ASB) : ASB Circle (Both Sides)
Encircles the MBA Block and MBA canteen on both sides.
