Instructions:

Sorting of Faculty into Groups based on last digit of employee ID

If the last digit of your employee ID is '0', your group number will be '0' and so forth.

Groups 0-9 will be formed on the basis of the last digit of your employee ID.

Classroom Allotment for Discussion:

C401 – Group 1,

C402 – Group 2 and so on up to C409 – Group 9

C410 – Group 0

Allotted time for Discussion is 30 minutes. (3.45 -4.15pm)

All faculty should reassemble at Amriteshwari Hall by 420 pm for their group presentations.

Each group will be allotted 2 min for presenting the synopsis of their discussion.

Themes:

1. How we plan to integrate IKS into the B.Tech curriculum

(For example: 'We plan to offer an open elective to all first-year students where Maths 101 will be taught in Tamil / Telugu / Hindi to help students appreciate engineering concepts in their mother tongue'. Give specific details of the course content with 1-2 specific examples and evaluation pattern)

2. How we plan to integrate IKS into Research

(For example: Research Proposal on 'A study of the benefits of practicing yoga and meditation on stress levels in students during examinations'.)

Presentation should contain:

- a. Brief synopsis of the research proposal
- b. Highlight the IKS component and multidisciplinary nature of the project
- c. Timeline of the project
- d. Expected outcomes and relevance to IKS
