

Advisory – Students Behavior in the Campus

To: The UG/PG Students and PhD Scholars of Coimbatore Campus

It is the responsibility of every member of the Amrita fraternity to uphold the foundational values and culture of the University. Maintaining respectable distance and professionalism among individuals of the opposite gender is a culture the University expects from everyone.

Students have been found to indulge in unacceptable behavior (close physical proximity) while sitting as pairs on pathways, staircases, and in areas with less lighting on the campus. This creates an embarrassing situation for other students, faculty, staff members, visitors, and parents. Such unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated on the campus.

Friendship can be maintained without the need for close physical proximity. In spite of repeated instructions, students of the opposite gender have been found in unacceptably close physical proximity.

Strict and appropriate action will be initiated through the Deans/Principals of the respective schools against students indulging in such unacceptable behavior. It may be noted that parents will be called to the campus on short notice in the event of repeated violations by a student.

The respective office bearers and student members of the various clubs will be collectively responsible for ensuring good conduct, a decent working environment, and healthy junior–senior interaction among the student community on the campus.

All faculty, staff, and security personnel of Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, Coimbatore Campus, have the authority to question such unacceptable behavior, confiscate student ID cards, and report the matter to the competent authorities for appropriate action.



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
