For the high jump, volunteers assisted in fixing the bar at the required height and promptly placing it back whenever it fell, allowing the event to continue smoothly.



On the final day, the finals of several events were conducted, creating excitement among athletes and spectators alike. The athletic meet concluded with a valedictory ceremony, which marked the successful completion of the three-day event.
