



Intramural staff tournament 2025-2026

Following are the general **rules and regulations** for the conduct of intramural staff tournament 2025-2026:

➤ **Eligibility criteria for participation:**

1. Participation is restricted to Employees and Ph.D (Part time and Full time) Research Scholars of the Ettimadai campus.
2. Any violation will result in instant disqualification of the team or individual.

➤ All games will be conducted on knock-out basis.

➤ **Table Tennis:** All rounds will be held on best of three sets for 11 points.

➤ **Chess:** Each player will have 30 minutes per round

➤ **Carrom:** First team to hit 29 points wins. Change of partner will not be permitted in between the tournament.

➤ **Badminton:** Rally point system will be followed. All rounds will be conducted for best of three sets of 21 points.

➤ **Cricket:** Full team list must be submitted to the organizers during the time of fixtures meeting. Inclusion of players after the commencement of the tournament will not be entertained. Semi final and Final will be conducted for 20 overs. Other initial rounds will be conducted for 16 overs. Anyone taking part in stitched ball cricket is restricted from playing tennis ball cricket and vice versa. T20 rules will be followed. If a match ends in a "tie", it proceeds to a Super Over, in which each team plays a single additional over of six balls to determine the match winner. A team consists max. of 16 players.

No kits will be provided for practice. Umpiring and scoring will be managed by the staff.

➤ **Tennis ball cricket:** T20 rules will be followed. Semi final and Final will be played for 15 overs and all other initial rounds will be held for 12 overs. Super over will be conducted to break the tie. A team consists max. of 16 players.

Umpiring and scoring will be managed by the staff.

➤ **Sevens football:** Duration of the match will be 20-5-20. A team consists max. of 10 players.

➤ **Volleyball:** A team consists max. of 12 players. All rounds will be conducted for best of three sets of 25 points.

➤ **Tenni-koit:** All rounds will be conducted for best of three sets of 15 rally points.

➤ All individual and team participants shall comply with the allotted date and time without deviation.
