

Hostel accommodation for the academic year 2022-2023 Instructions to students of the 2020 batch

Greetings.....,

25 July 2022

Accommodation in the hostel will be made available **two days prior to the class commencement date.**

1. Hostellers are requested to remit the hostel and mess fee on or before 02.09.2022
2. Hostel and mess fee can be paid online through the CMS portal from 10th August 2022 using the link: Login to <https://cms.cb.amrita.edu/login>
3. Due to the sudden increase in admissions in 2020, the hostel students' strength increased drastically. In order to accommodate all the willing students into the hostels, we are forced to accommodate 5 students per room on a temporary basis till new hostel blocks are built and become operational.
4. There might be a few students who would leave the campus on Internship for their VIII semester. In such cases, based on the availability, 2020 batch students might be allotted single-bedded accommodation also.
5. Hostel students whose place of residence is in Coimbatore/Palakkad are requested to prefer to become day scholars in order to help the students coming from far-off places.
6. The revised hostel and mess fee for this academic year (2022-2023) is as follows:
 - Hostel fee – Rs. 40,000/- per annum – 5 occupancy rooms for boys
 - Hostel fee – Rs. 47,000/- per annum – 4 occupancy rooms for boys and girls
 - Mess fee – Rs. 56,000/- per annum

Due to shortage of rooms, accommodation will be confirmed for only those students who have paid the hostel and mess fee on or before 02.09.2022.

Please note that if a student wants to become a day scholar during this academic year, you may inform the hostel office by sending an email to: ccwh@cb.amrita.edu on or before 31st August 2022. You need to submit a hard copy of the "Hosteller to Day Scholar" (Form - 002) form duly signed by the parent when you report for your class on the first day of Odd Semester 2022-2023.
