29.1 Confirmation of the minutes of the 28th Meeting of the Academic Council held on 08.11.2016.

29.2 Revised list of faculties in the University and Programmes grouped under each faculty

The revised list of faculties was approved with the following modifications. Two more faculties were added to the list placed for consideration of the Academic Council; namely the faculty of Education and the faculty for Interdisciplinary Studies. Accordingly, the B.Ed. programme was moved from the faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences to the faculty for Education. Also, the programme of M.C.A. was moved from the faculty of Engineering to the faculty of Science. Also it was decided that the term ‘sciences’ is to be replaced by the word ‘science’. 29.3.1 Introduction of BBA (specialization in Logistics Management) programme at School of Arts & Sciences, Kochi with an annual intake of 60 students from the academic year 2017-18.

How to apply? Apply online through <http://aoap.amrita.edu>

Important dates: Submission of application ends on May 1st.

Selection procedure:

First round selection will be based on the performance in the contests hosted by CodeChef, CodeForces & Hackerearth. Students shall attend

- Monthly “Cookoff” & “Lunchtime” contests in CodeChef,
- “Div 2” contests in CodeForces,
- Monthly “Easy” and “Circuits” in Hackerearth.

Students willing to pursue B Tech Honours programme shall compete in the monthly contests in above online judges starting from April. Those who are already practicing / or participated will get preference.

Select students will be invited to Amritapuri/ Coimbatore campuses to attend an onsite contest. Contest will be of 5 hours duration with more than 4 problems of easy, medium and hard-level. Judging is completely automated. Selection is based on the rank scored in the online contest. The contest is expected to be held in the first/second week of June. Refer to the INOI syllabus in <http://www.iarcs.org.in/inoi/online-study-material/topics/>. The problems will be based on implementation, basic mathematics and algorithms. Students are expected to have a sound knowledge in algorithm concepts and its implementation in problem solving.

Problems will be set by ICPC World Finalists, Google Code Jam winners, facebook Hackercup winners, etc.

The list of selected students shall be notified by the Dean (Engg.), based on the recommendations of Br. Anand Shenoi of Amritapuri (B Tech – Hons. Programme Coordinator)

Curriculum:

Students admitted to the B Tech Honours programme will follow the prescribed 2015 curriculum and the rules and regulations.

Number of seats: **Amritapuri** – 10; and **Coimbatore** – 10

29.4.4 New Ph.D Regulations

A draft of Ph.D. Regulations was discussed. It was decided to have further discussions on the matter and to place the same for approval in the next Academic Council. The format of the first page of the Ph.D. thesis, the certificate from the thesis advisor and the declaration of the student and the format for the Ph.D. degree certificate were discussed and finalised with the condition that the font and font size will be decided by the Dean, PG Programmes. The finalised formats of the above mentioned documents are given as Annexure 29.4.4.

It was also decided that every Ph.D. candidate should submit along with the Ph.D. thesis a declaration that the Ph.D. thesis report he/she is submitting is free of plagiarism.

29.4.5 Exempting the six students of the 2013 batch of the 5 year Integrated MA ELL programme at Coimbatore in July 2016, who have switched over to the newly introduced 2 year MA programme in “English Literature and Literary Theory” from the ‘Exit option project’ and on completion of all the requirements at the end of the five years, be eligible to be awarded BA degree in English Language and Literature and MA degree in English Literature and Literary Theory in the convocation to be held in the year 2018. This is to be treated as a special case and shall not be quoted as precedence.

29.4.6 Inclusion of names of two Thesis Advisors or only one Thesis Advisor, in the Thesis, in a situation arising out of a Thesis Advisor, leaving AMRITA either on retirement or resignation.

It was decided that such issues will be considered on a 'case by case' basis and the final decision be taken by the Dean, PG programme based on recommendation from the PGP Chair of the faculty.

29.4.7. Approval of Regulations for the UG Programme in Ayurveda.

The draft of the Regulations presented were discussed. It was decided to approve the Regulations by modifying the clause on dropping of the course. The Regulations approved by the Academic Council is given as Annexure 29.4.7.
