Similarly compliance measures to rectify any shortcomings mentioned against any institution should be initiated. The same should be reported in the next academic council.

- 28.12 It was decided that the Seed Grant Funding in each campus would be finalised by the Director of Research of that campus and the campus Accounts Department can take suitable decision to release the grants. Any further clarification needed on releasing the amount will be provided by the Pro-Chancellor.
- 28.13 The status of NIRF data collected was discussed. It was noted that the data provided by the School of Medicine was incomplete and the data from Centre for nanosciences were not available. The representatives from these schools/centres were requested to take immediate action.
- 28.14 The status of preparation of the Review Report for UGC Inspection for extension of approval of Deemed University status was discussed. It was decided that all institutions provide forthwith to the University headquarters the details to be included in the review report and the compiled report be whetted by a committee consisting of Dr. Sasangan Ramanathan, Dr. Sreeram Devanathan, Dr. Balakrishnan Shankar, Dr. Shanti Nair and Dr. Vasudevan or Dr. Pratapan Nair before it is sent to the inspection committee members.
