### **Academics & Examinations**

- Board of Studies must meet more frequently
- Open book exams may be added
- Less Emphasis on arts and sciences
- More super-speciality programs in Ayurveda
- Promote more graduate programs with inter-disciplinary and cross-disciplinary orientation

### **Faculty**

- Faculty Cadre Ratio (1 Professor: 2 Associate Professor: 6 Assistant Professor) is not maintained as per norms
- All faculty to get UGC pay scale and other benefits such as PF, medical reimbursement, loan, insurance etc

### **Administration & Finance**

- Better involvement of faculty in policy planning and decision is favorable
- More financial power to be delegated
- Perspective plan for short and long term to be systematically developed especially for promotion of basic sciences, humanities, arts & culture
- Apply for 12B status of UGC and university with potential for excellence

### **Library**

- Number of books and journals in library to be increased

### **Research & Consultancy**

- Limited faculty is involved in consultancy work
- A structured mechanism to promote research consultancy is to be augmented
- Exclusive publication unit at university with focus on publishing our own research journals

## **Industry**

- Strong industry-institute linkage needed
- Technology Business Incubator (TBI) needed

## **Students**

- Student representation in academic committees
- Increase sports, games and cultural activities at national and international levels

- IQAC needs to make efforts to coordinate with various stakeholders for institutionalizing various initiatives
