Totally 57 students from 2021 batch attended the NSS special camp. The inaugural programme began with a prayer song by Ms. Poorna Somathmajan of 2021 batch and the programme was convened by Ms. M.R. Anjali and Ms. Harsana of 2021 batch. Dr. K. Murugasridevi, NSS Programme Officer, NSS Unit 6 welcomed the gathering and delivered the plan of work of NSS special camp. After this, the inaugural address of NSS special camp was delivered by Mrs. S. Umagowri, Headmistress, Government High School, Myleripalayam. She felt very happy to welcome our students to do service for the school. She also encouraged the students to work happily during the camp. The day initiated with Yoga session for school students by NSS student volunteers. “Demonstrations on plant protection measures among the farmers of Myleripalayam” was conducted at a farmer’s residence, Myleripalayam. Dr. K. Kamesh Krishnamoorthy, Assistant Professor (Plant Pathology) demonstrated the methodology of preparing Bordeaux mixture and explained about disease management in coconut and banana. Dr. S. Parthasarathy cleared the doubts of farmers regarding disease management in various crops. Dr. K. Murugasridevi explained about the management of coconut pests with respect to Rhinoceros beetle and Rugose spiralling whitefly in coconut and also gave clarifications on pest management. Following this, in view of maximizing farmers income through value addition, Dr. S. Thirukkumar, Assistant Professor (Food Science) explained the processing techniques of value-added products of tomato, cereals, pulses, banana, millets and coconut. He also emphasized on business model skills, entrepreneurship skills, health and hygiene practices to be followed.

Valedictory function of NSS special camp was conducted on 24.03.2022 at Government High school, Myleripalayam. The valedictory programme commenced with a prayer song by Ms.

Navya S Nair of 2021 batch. The programme was compered by Mr. Souradh and Ms. Rithi Varshita of 2021 batch. Ms. D. Harshitha of 2021 batch welcomed the gathering.

After this, Valedictory address was delivered by Dr. Sudheesh Manalil, Associate Dean, Head Research, and PGP chair, Amrita School of Agricultural Sciences. He remembered the Rural Agricultural Working Experience of our college students at Myleripalayam village and insisted that students should always be prepared to learn the strategies of cultivation from the growers. He appreciated the eminent service done by the NSS student volunteers especially painting of the classroom, plastic waste removal and parthenium eradication in the school premise. He also elaborated that people in developed countries like Australia do their household chores for themselves to avoid paying a huge amount to manpower. In addition, he cherished our NSS student volunteers for eradicating parthenium from the school premises and explained the ill effects of noxious parthenium weed which causes indigestion, anxiety, allergic reactions, exhausted feeling after sleep, and respiratory issues. Associate dean also insisted on the importance of using cloth bags over the usage of plastic carry bags for buying things. Finally, he felt very happy with our NSS student volunteers for undertaking this service in the school. Following this, a Special address was delivered by Mrs. Gomathi Thirumoorthy, President, Myleripalayam, followed by Mrs. S. Umagowri, Head mistress, Government High School, Myleripalayam. Then, a Special address was given by Mrs. Sumathi, Headmistress, Panchayat Union Primary School, Myleripalayam. After this, prize distribution was done by the dignitaries for the winners of various events. Dr. K. Murugasridevi, NSS Programme Officer delivered the vote of thanks. 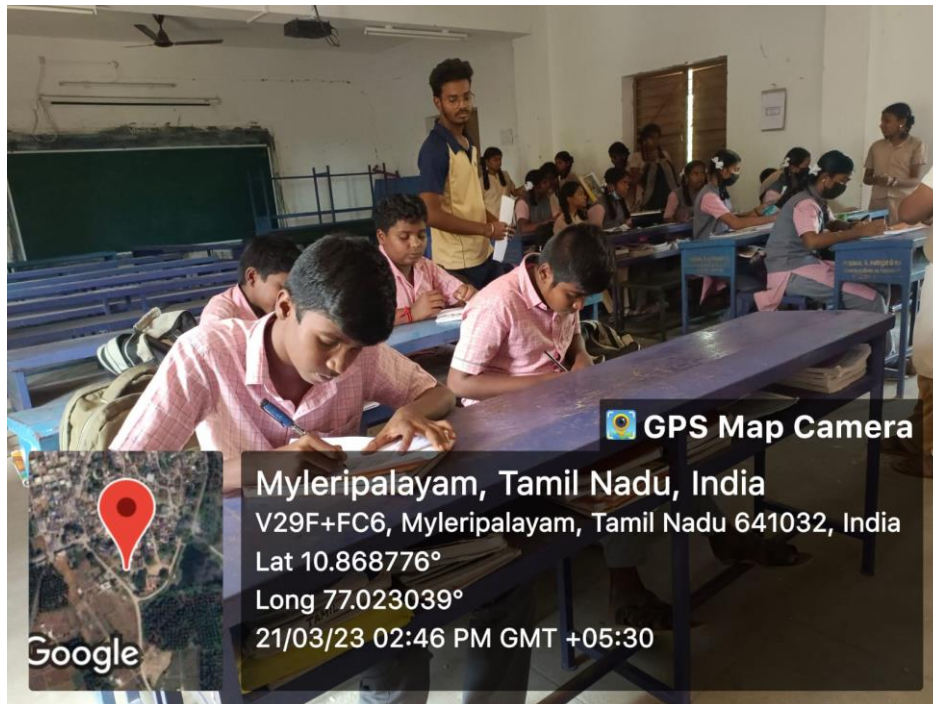

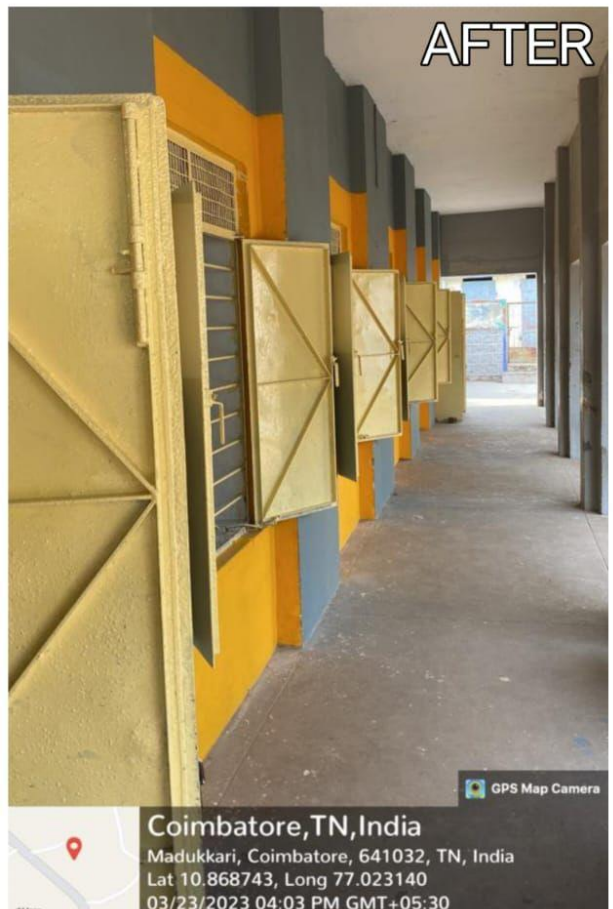

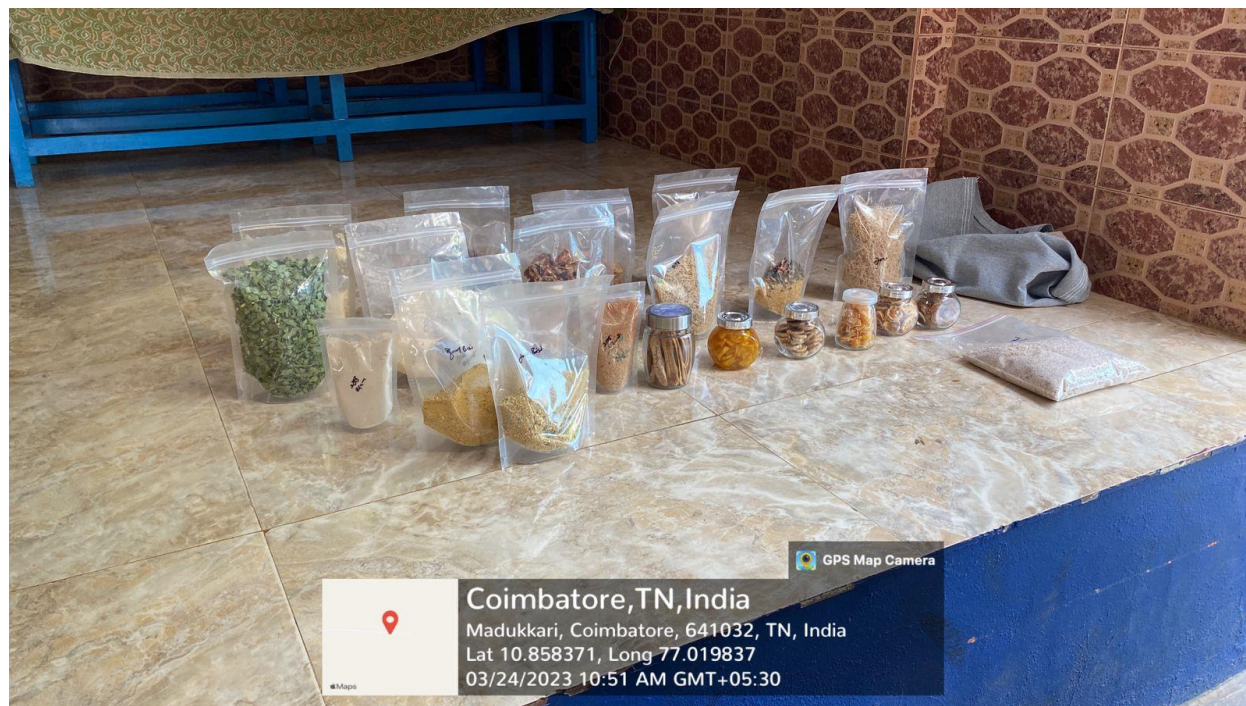
