## **Introduction:**

This report presents an overview of the National Service Scheme (NSS) NEET Survey conducted from 1st August 2023 to 3rd August 2023 in villages in and around Ettimadai. The primary objective of the NEET Survey was to conduct surveys focusing on unemployment and lack of formal education in rural areas. The NEET Survey witnessed the active participation of 16 enthusiastic volunteers headed by Dr. D. Venkataraman, NSS Programme Co-ordinator who worked tirelessly to collect valuable data and contribute to empowering the rural communities.

## **Objective:**

The main purpose of the NSS NEET Survey was to conduct surveys and gather information about the challenges faced by the rural population, specifically concerning unemployment and limited access to

formal education. The data collected would be used to advocate for new government schemes and policies aimed at addressing these issues.

### **Activities:**

Each day of the NEET Survey, the volunteers dedicated approximately 3 hours to conducting surveys in the targeted villages. The activities included approaching households, engaging with the locals, and collecting responses to structured questionnaires. The team aimed to cover as many homes as possible to ensure a representative and comprehensive survey. In this process of collecting data, the villager's cooperation was immense and overwhelming to us. They welcomed all of us with open hearts.
