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Unit I: संज्ञापरिभाषम् (Samjna & Paribhasha) Introduction to Samjna and Paribhasha. Classification and characteristics of Samjnas. Analysis of key definitions and terminologies.

Unit II: पञ्चसन्धिप्रकरणम् (Pancha Sandhis) Explanation of the five types of Sandhi (junctions) in Sanskrit grammar. Identification and application of Sandhi rules in textual analysis. Practical exercises on Sandhi resolution.

Unit III: कारक-स्त्रीप्रत्ययप्रकरणम् (Karaka & Stri Pratyaya) Understanding the concept of Karaka (semantic roles) and Stri Pratyaya (feminine suffixes). Analysis of Karaka categories and their functions in sentence construction. Application of Karaka theory in parsing and interpreting Sanskrit sentences.

Unit IV: समासप्रकरणम् (Samasa)

Overview of compound formation in Sanskrit grammar. Classification and analysis of different types of compounds (Samasa). Practical exercises on identifying and analyzing compound formations.

Unit V: कृत्-तद्धितप्रकरणम् (Krt & Taddhita Suffixes) Study of Krt (primary suffixes) and Taddhita (secondary suffixes). Analysis of the formation and functions of Krt and Taddhita forms in Sanskrit. Practical exercises on parsing and interpreting sentences containing Krt and Taddhita suffixes.
