
Unlock educational access to Autodesk products

Step 2 :- Select Get Started or Sign In.


Step 3:- To create an account, fill in the following information.


Step 7:-

- ➤ Click the "VERIFY EMAIL" link in your email










Step 13 :- Click "Get Started" under Autocad or Inventor or Revit TAB.



A date within the current school term. Preferred documents include: Transcript School-issued confirmation letter A copy of your student ID (photo ID not required) Supported file types: JPEG, PDF, PNG, GIF Drag documents here, or browse NOTE: If your uploaded document is too fuzzy to read, does not show your full and legal name, or show a name different from the one you used for this Autodesk account, you will not be able to complete the confirmation process. Please do not include any confidential information in the document you upload, such as social security numbers or banking details. Please ensure any sensitive information is blacked out before you upload your document.

Step 16:- Click browse and Upload YOUR COLLEGE **ID CARD/issued letter***PHOTO or SCANNED COPY

*for Fresher's Provisional Admission Order (PAO) SCANNED COPY can be uploaded.





Step 17: Verification is manually processed and will take less than one business day.




Installing Autocad/Inventor/Revit Steps

Step 18:- Once you have a verified account, Autodesk will send an email as shown below, click **Get Products** and be transferred to Autodesk website. Now log in to your personal registered account.



Step 19:- Choose the application(Autocad/Inventor/Revit) that you wish to install. There is also a link to each applications **System Requirements** which you should check beforehand. Most of the Autodesk applications are large download files and also can take up a large amount of space on your computer - check you have sufficient space.




Step 20:- Choose the version and installation you require. For compatibility you should ensure this is the same version recommended for your course. Scroll to the bottom of the page.




Step 21:- We need to select the **School**, **Version**, **Operating system**, and the **Language** from the drop-down list. After this step, the download will begin.

Note:- Make a note of the **Serial number** and the **Product key**, which will be shown on your screen. You will need these the first time you launch AutoCAD/Inventor/Revit.





Note: We can select the particular version from the drop-down list according to the requirements. The system requirements for that version will be displayed accordingly.

Step 22 :- Copy 'Serial Number' & 'Product Key' in Notepad & save it on Computer Drive




Step 23 :- Click on 'Download Now' & save the file to a designated drive







Step 24: Open the File Downloaded in the drive & click 'Run'










Step 25 :- Click on 'OK'




Step 26: Select any designated folder & Click 'OK'




Step 27: Setup has been downloaded now click on 'Install'

Step 29: Click the Browse... button to select the directory to store the installation file, and then Click Install.




Step 30: Zone the installation process is finished, Click **Launch Now** to launch the software.




Step 31:-

- On the Let's Get Started screen, click the Enter a Serial Number link. The screen may differ depending on product version and other factors.




Step 32 :- Click On 'I Agree'




Step 33:- On the Product License Activation screen; Click Activate






Step 34 :- Copy the saved serial key & paste it in this column.




Step 32:- Enter a valid **Serial Number** and **Product Key** then click **NEXT**.

Step 33: Your License is activated & Click Finish.




Step 34: - Start your Autodesk product.




Step 35:-
