ANTI RAGGING SQUADS:2019-20

- As per instructions issued by UGC, strict Anti-Ragging Measures are required to be instituted within the Campus. UGC Further mandates that Anti-Raging Squads comprising of teaching and non teaching staff need to be formed both during working and non-working hours to thwart any attempt at ragging. The incidents of ragging occur mostly during the non working hours and holidays.
- Responsibility for organizing Anti- Ragging Squads:
 - CCWH. Hostels
 - Security Officer: Common Areas (Convention Hall, Hangar area, Premises near GYM, Estate Office corner, Ashram Road and Parking Area outside railway gate).
 - Departments: Labs & Dept Premises.
- Ragging Prone Stretches and Responsibilities: The under mentioned stretches that are generally prone to ragging should be monitored by the assigned Depts by nominating Anti-Ragging squads of faculty/staff. The respective Dept Vice Chairpersons/ nominated faculty shall coordinate this activity.
