DAY-1

All six NSS Unit of Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham inaugurated their 5 day NSS Special Camp at the Amriteshwari hall in the campus at 9:30 AM on 3rd of February. It was inaugurated by Dr. K Shailendra, the Professor of Students Welfare. The camp was held from 3rd of February till 7th of February under the Theme of "Village development".





To emphasis on a cleaner India, we considered it to be our responsibility to Promote cleanliness in the small ways that we could. So, on the first day, Students were taken to Ettimadai village to clean the surroundings, keeping the Spirits of Swachh Bharat in mind. Students split themselves into smaller groups and engaged themselves in various tasks such as plucking weeds, clearing out Plastics, segregating the waste collected into degradable and non- degradable.

Poisonous plants like *parthenium* and thorny plants were also removed with the help of Gloves. Once these tasks were over, students also did a thorough sweep of the village. There exists a dried-up pond in this village. In an effort to clear it of weeds and waste, the municipality was also contacted. A JCB arranged by the municipality also arrived on the site for desilting the pond.











DAY-2

"Everything that begins well ends well."

On the second day, the students visited the village of Puthupathy. Puthupathy is a tribal village close to the Western ghats reserved forests of Coimbatore. It is near Walayar and comes under the jurisdiction of Madukkarai. It is a village plagued by the frequent disturbances of elephants due to its close proximity to the forest. On reaching the village, students first cleaned the village hall. It was swept and dusted. After this, the NSS camp was inaugurated in Puthupathy by Mr. Ganesan, esteemed Headmaster of the Government school of Puthupathy.

The program started with a prayer song to invoke the blessings of the almighty and the dignitaries were welcomed by Mr. Prabu, our faculty coordinator. The students of the government school of Puthupathy attended the function.





The volunteers were split into groups and performed various tasks respectively. A group of volunteers went to the preschool to clean and paint the blackboards. The other groups spread out across the village and started collecting the waste materials. The collected waste was segregated into degradable and non-degradable waste. The degradable wastes were buried into a pit dug by our volunteers to be made into fertilizer. The kids of the village were taught proper hygiene methods. Proper ways of hand washing was taught to the kids.







DAY-3

The village Community hall of Puthupathy is an important place in the village. It is used for many important functions and meetings. So it is necessary for it to be in its optimal state. As such our volunteers started scraping off old poster markings and paint off the wall.





A talk on ill effects of tobacco was organized by eminent speakers from the Government Health Department .During the interactive session with the Students, they spoke about health hazards of tobacco consumption. They also appealed the students to persuade their family members to let go of the addictive habit. It was evident from the response of the students that the talk was very convincing and students clearly understood that tobacco in any form is very fatal.



After the talk a yoga session was arranged. The main aim was to raise awareness and ignite a passion for fitness among the students. A few minutes of yoga during the day can be a great way to get rid of the stress that accumulates in both body and mind. Not just this but it also helps the body to stay active throughout the day. Keeping this in mind yoga postures, Pranayama and Meditation techniques were taught to the children. A free dental camp was organised for everyone. The volunteers coordinated all the villagers to attend the camp.





DAY-4

A drawing competition was conducted and students were organised into different categories according to their age groups. Crayons, colouring books and sketch pens were given away to bring out their creative skills. The students participated with enthusiasm as everyone wanted to win prizes. All the students were assisted by the volunteers. Kids enjoyed our company.



After the drawing competition various cultural events like dance, musical chairs and singing competitions were conducted. The students rocked on the floor and astonished everyone with their talent. It was indeed a great afternoon. Simultaneously, a group was working on the arrangements required for tree planting. After the conclusion of cultural events, trees were planted by the kids and everyone was given the responsibility of nurturing the newly planted saplings. At tea time, snacks was distributed to the residents of the village.

Keeping in mind Our Honourable Prime minister Narendra Modi 's Fit India Movement, An official "SPORTS DAY" for the school was organised. Various events and competitions were conducted.
