Due to the surge in COVID-19 cases, the University has decided to postpone student entry to the campus.

The following changes to the previously issued Office Communication (Ref: AMRITA/CBE/SOE/12/2021/09) will go into effect immediately:

1. Semester VII exams for the students of Mechanical, ECE and EIE programs **will be held online** as per the schedule released by the Office of DyCoE. In addition, ensuing semester classes will also be held online until further notice.
2. Semester III exams for the students of MSW **will be held online** as per the schedule released by the Office of DyCoE. Ensuing semester classes will also be held online.
3. Current semester classes for the following programs **will be held online** instead of the previously scheduled offline classes. Students of the following programs are not required to report to the campus.
  - a. Integrated M.Sc. 2018 (Maths, Data Science, Physics, Chemistry)
  - b. Integrated M. Sc. 2020 (Mathematics, Data Science, Physics, Chemistry)
  - c. B. A. 2020 (English Language & Literature)
  - d. B. A. 2020 (Mass Communication)
  - e. M. Sc. 2021 (Mathematics, Applied Statistics and Data Analytics, Physics, Chemistry)

If travel arrangements for International students and students currently residing abroad cannot be altered, they will be allowed to come to the campus and will be subject to quarantine period as per guidance from the COVID-19 Cell.
