25 Mar - 31 Mar 2017

(24-03-2017)

The official commencement of the NSS Special Camp took place at Amriteshwari Hall at 4:30pm by seeking the Lord's blessings with a prayer song.

Dr. Elangovan introduced us to NSS and the villages adopted by Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham. He also briefed us regarding its requirements. The meeting ended with the Programme Officers discussing the proposed plans with the respective volunteers. Our unit was assigned the Muruganpathy village.

(25-03-2017)

The volunteers for the special camp were taken to the government school in Ettimadai for the Inauguration of the event. The event was presided by Dr. S Mahadevan, the Deputy Dean of Engineering, Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham.

The event began with the prayer song followed by motivational addresses by the Program Officers. The event was officially inaugurated by the Dr. Mahadevan. To inculcate a sense of integrity, the volunteers prepared dinner collectively and the event concluded with the dinner being served.

(26-03-2017)

The programme officers asked us to report by 8:30 am near Amriteshwari Hall. We departed for the Ettimadai government school to get the amenities and the tools required for the camp site. The journey began from the Ettimadai government school with a prayer. We reached the village around 10.30 am. We were warmly greeted by the school authorities and the students. We briefed about the work to be done in the school, painting the walls of the school building. The volunteers of Unit 2 at once got to work with full enthusiasm and vigour. After a tedious morning, the volunteers mingled with the school students and spent the time educating, playing and grooming their personality. Games like cricket, Carom were played to imbibe teamwork, coordination, decision making and healthy competition.

This was followed by a hearty lunch provided by the unit present at the Ettimadai government school. The rest of the day was well spent with the kids and the school authorities.

(27-03-2017)
